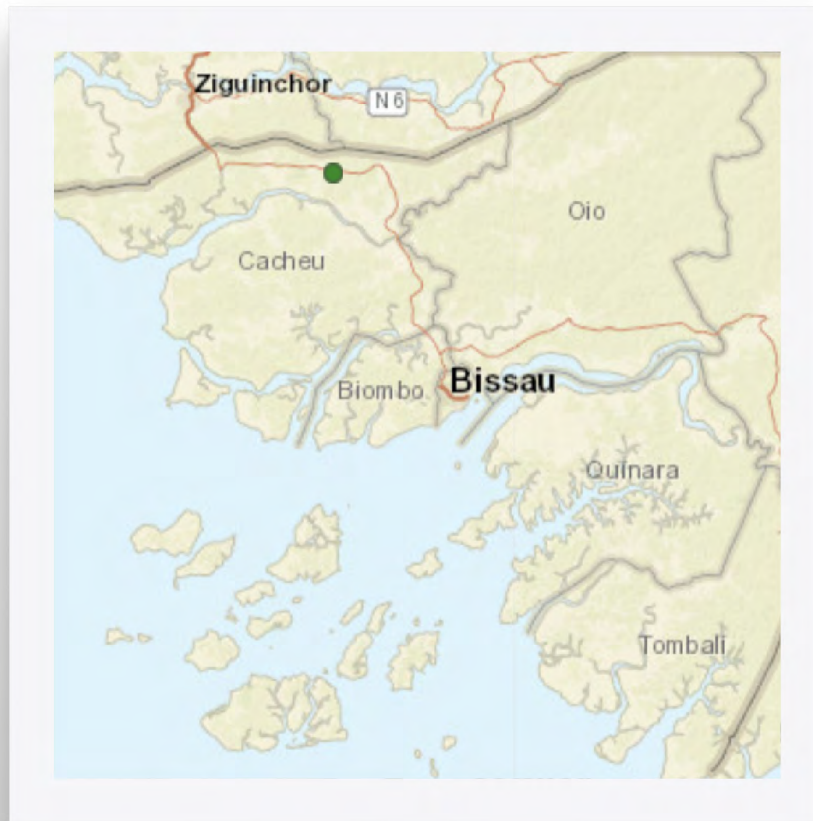
TESTIMONY

KASANGA OF GUINEA-BISSAU



The Kasanga of Guinea-Bissau, numbering 1,100, are Unengaged and Unreached. Less than 2% are evangelical, and there is no active CP activity. They are part of the Atlantic people cluster within the Sub-Saharan African affinity bloc. This people group is only found in Guinea Bissau. Their primary language is Kasanga. The primary religion practiced by the Kasanga is animism, a religious worldview that natural physical entities--including animals, plants, and even inanimate objects--possess a spiritual essence.
