The next day, burdened by the evil I had committed in the village and towards my parents, I sought out the man of God, longing to be liberated from these practices. He prayed with me, and I willingly accepted Jesus Christ as my Lord and Savior. Since that transformative day, my life has been filled with peace.

It was very difficult for me during the first two days to gather the people together. But on the third day a brother asked me to start with even just a few people and gradually more people came by themselves. In the village of Ikélemba the chief did not want us to share the Gospel, he said the village belongs to their ancestors. He informed us that we must avoid preaching and speaking against their customs because they have rituals every weekend. A week later, God touched one of the notaries who then received Jesus and welcomed us into his home. So we say thank you to our Almighty God. NGONDI CONGO REPUBLIC HEALTH CENTER



*The Ngandikolo Medical Center in Congo Brazzaville was established to assist the Ngondi people. We face two main challenges. Firstly, the cost of construction materials is high. Secondly, we are struggling to find a nurse who can work at the center on a permanent basis. Currently, we are conducting a malaria screening campaign and offering consultations and screenings for diabetes and common illnesses. This depends on nurse availability and is done in partnership with the Ouesso base hospital until we can secure a permanent nurse. While this temporary arrangement costs us more in transportation, it has yielded positive results. Over the past months, we have reached more than 173 people. Among them, 74 people heard about the gospel for the first time, and 22 accepted Christ. **NCM Field Staff Bongo Jean Baptiste***
