TESTIMONY

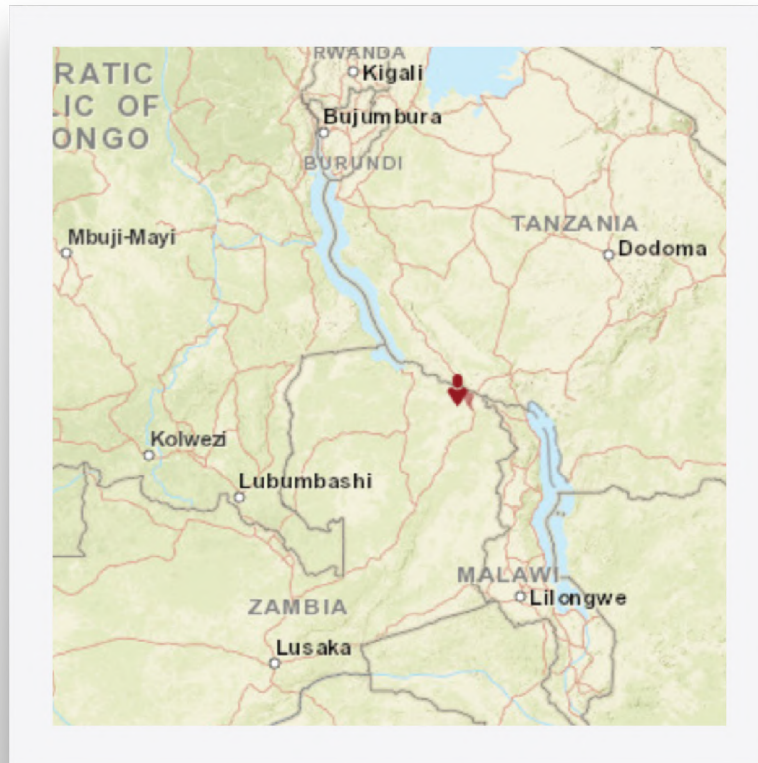

TAMBO OF ZAMBIA



The Tambo of Zambia, numbering 28,000, are Unengaged and Unreached. They are part of the Bantu, Central-Tanzania people cluster within the Sub-Saharan African affinity bloc. This people group is only found in Zambia. Their primary language is Nyamwanga. The primary religion practiced by the Tambo is ethnoreligion. Ethnoreligion is deeply rooted in a people's ethnic identity and conversion essentially equates to cultural assimilation.
