IVORY COAST CLEAN WATER PROJECT

Our clean water project in the remote village of Okabo, situated in Mankono, Ivory Coast, continues to be a success. This project positively affected 1,700 people in total. Among them, 175 "Baule" animists,

68 "Mossi" Muslims, 137 "Senufo" animists, and 90 "Jula" Muslims had the opportunity to hear the gospel. Furthermore, 35 Baule and 7 Senufo individuals found salvation through this initiative.

"Nearly a year later, we continue to be deeply thankful to God and the individuals who generously funded this project for us here. We never thought this would happen in our very remote village. The amazing thing is that the water we use and drink is the purest in the whole region and people are coming to enjoy this blessing. Dirty water diseases are all gone and our children are now healthy."
