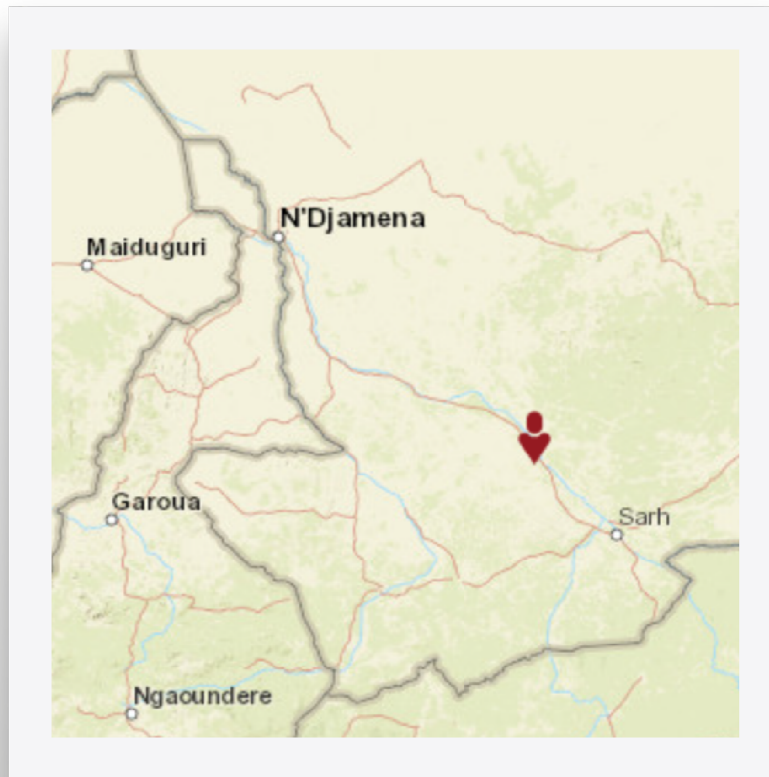
TESTIMONY & EXPERIENCE

BOOR OF CHAD



The Boor of Chad, numbering 375, are Unengaged and Unreached. There are no evangelicals, churches or resources in the area. They are part of the Chadic people cluster within the Sub-Saharan African affinity bloc. This people group is only found in Chad. Their primary language is Boor. The primary religion practiced by the Boor is Sunni Islam, the largest branch of Islam. Sunni Muslims follow the teachings of the Qur'an and consider the first four caliphs to be the rightful successors of Muhammad.
