

BELI OF SOUTH SUDAN



The Beli of South Sudan, numbering 86,000, are Unengaged and Unreached. They are part of the Sudanic people cluster within the Sub-Saharan African affinity bloc. This people group is only found in South Sudan. Their primary language is Beli (South Sudan). The primary religion practiced by the Beli is animism, a religious worldview that natural physical entities--including animals, plants, and even inanimate objects--possess a spiritual essence.
