GULA IRO OF CHAD



The Gula Iro of Chad, numbering 5,300, are Unengaged and Unreached. Less than 2% are Evangelical believers and there is no active church planting activity. They are part of the Adamawa -Ubangi people cluster within the Sub-Saharan African affinity bloc. This people group is only found in Chad. Their primary language is Gula Iro. The primary religion practiced by the Gula Iro is marginal Christianity, a form of religion with roots in Christianity but not theologically Christian. We have already worked with partners on the ground to verify their status and we are ready to begin the recruiting process.
