FOODO OF BENIN



The Foodo of Benin, numbering 49,000, are Unengaged and Unreached. Less than 2% are evangelical, and there is no active CP activity. They are part of the Guinean people cluster within the Sub-Saharan African affinity bloc. This people group is only found in Benin. Their primary language is Foodo. The primary religion practiced by the Foodo is Folk Islam, a syncretistic belief system that blends traditional elements of Islam with superstitious practices such as warding off spirits with incantations and magic amulets, and reciting verses of the Qur'an to bring about miraculous healings.
